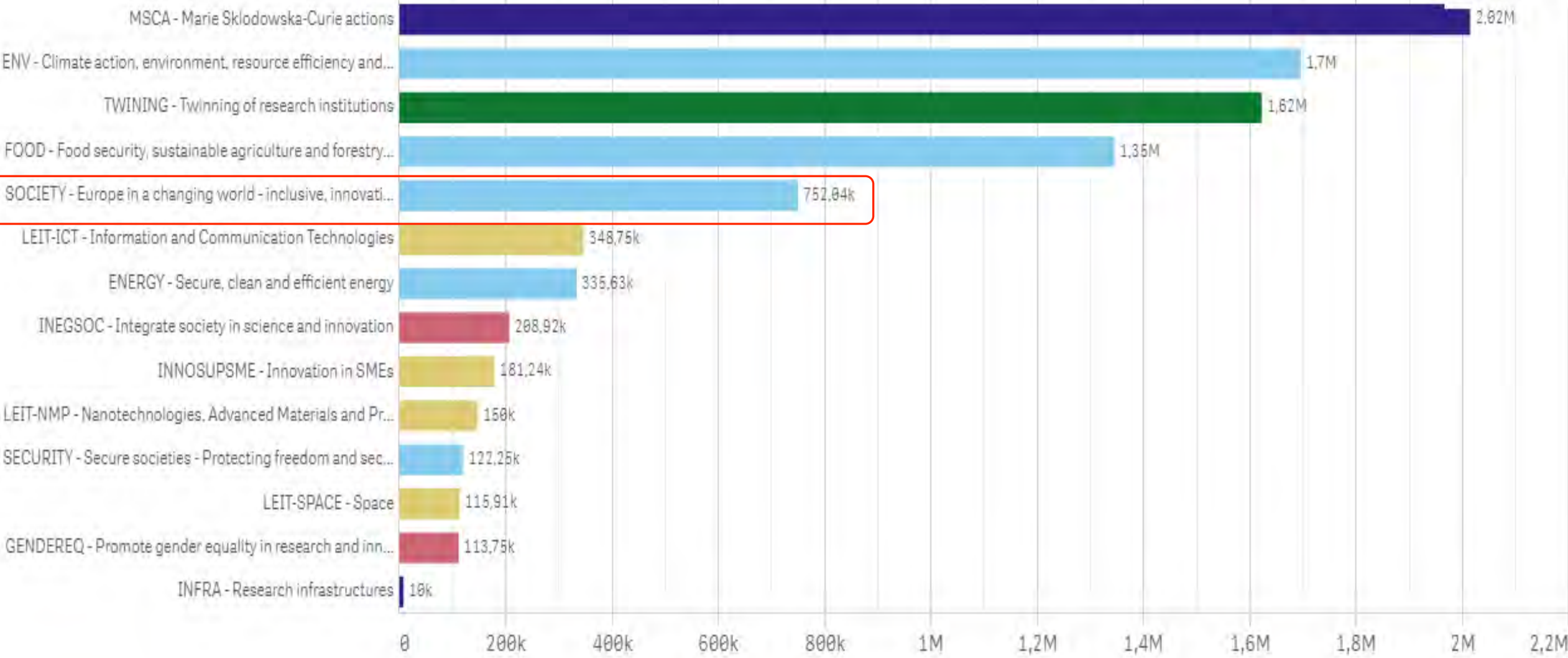

Eligibility Criteria

Experienced Researchers: in possession of a doctoral degree OR have at least four years of full-time equivalent research experience.

Nationality: Any.

Mobility: The researcher must not have resided or carried out his/her main activity (work, studies, etc.) in the country of the host organization for more than 12 months in the 3 years immediately prior to the deadline for submission of proposals (a relaxed rule for CAR and RI).

ADVANCED GRANTS ERC-2020-ADG



European Research Council

Topic Description

- Grants up to **2.5 € million** for 5 years
- For established research leaders with a recognised track record of research achievements during the last 10 years.
- **All scientific fields** are eligible for ERC funding

Topic Conditions

- Open to researchers of **any nationality**, research activity will be conducted in any EU Member State or H2020 Associated country.
- Principal Investigators may be of **any age**
- The **Host Institution** must either be established in an EU Member State or H2020 Associated country as a legal entity created under national law.

Deadline: 26 Aug 2020



EVALUATION CRITERIA



1. Research Project - Ground-breaking nature, ambition and feasibility

Ground-breaking nature and potential impact of the research project

- To what extent does the proposed research address important challenges?
- To what extent are the objectives ambitious and beyond the state of the art (e.g. novel concepts and approaches or development between or across disciplines)?
- To what extent is the proposed research high-risk/high-gain (i.e. if successful the payoffs will be very significant, but there is a high risk that the research project does not entirely fulfil its aims)?

Scientific Approach

- To what extent is the outlined scientific approach feasible bearing in mind the extent that the proposed research is high-risk/high-gain *[based on the Extended Synopsis at Step 1]*?
- To what extent are the proposed research methodology and working arrangements appropriate to achieve the goals of the project *[to be assessed at Step 2 based on the full Scientific Proposal]*?
- To what extent does the proposal involve the development of novel methodology *[to be assessed at Step 2 based on the full Scientific Proposal]*?
- To what extent are the proposed timescales, resources and PI commitment adequate and properly justified *[to be assessed at Step 2 based on the full Scientific Proposal]*?

2. Principal Investigator - Intellectual capacity and creativity

- To what extent has the PI demonstrated the ability to conduct ground-breaking research?
- To what extent does the PI have the required scientific expertise and capacity to successfully execute the project?
- To what extent has the PI demonstrated sound leadership in the training and advancement of young scientists?

SCOPE

- Les propositions doivent se concentrer sur les enseignements tirés :

IMPACT ATTENDU

- Améliorer la résilience, le bien-être et la santé mentale de la population, des travailleurs de première ligne et, en particulier, des groupes les plus vulnérables et atténuer les inégalités de santé;
- Meilleure compréhension de l'impact, de l'efficacité, de la préparation et des réponses en matière de santé publique;

CONSEILS ET CONDITIONS SUPPLÉMENTAIRES



- Fournir des résultats dans les 3 à 36 mois aux utilisateurs finaux à grande échelle.
 - De plus, s'il y a plus d'un projet financé, la coopération, la communication, la collaboration et la coordination entre les groupes de recherche seront fortement encouragées.
 - Contribution indicative de l'UE entre 4 et 10 millions d'euros.
